2024 FEI Youth Coordinator Fall Report

NAYC Fundraising

- Fundraising goal was \$10,700K to be used for NAYC 2025.
- Our annual online auction, coupled with a raffle for a \$500 Gift Certificate donated by The
 Distinguished Rider and braiding services at licensed competitions, we were able to meet our
 goal

NAYC Team Apparel Sponsorships

This year we were able to attain more sponsorships than ever before. Through sponsorship, our team athletes received: 9 team shirts (a shirt for each day), 2 ball caps, fleece jacket, rain jacket (VADA), backpack, grooming towels.

The jog outfit was sponsored by Marissa Gentner of the Distinguished Rider. Each athlete received a sun shirt, leather belt and a 50% discount on flag sneakers totaling over \$450 retail for each athlete.

NAYC Competition – July 30 through August 4, 2024, Traverse City, MI

Young Riders

- For the first time in 3 year we were able to field a full YR team! Team athletes in ranked order were: Abby Fodor (NJ), Sienna Rowe (VA), Evie Oliver (PA), and Tai Parrish (NJ).
- Team Competition: Our Team placed 5th overall. Individual top 15 results: Abby Fodor placed 9th (66.735), and Evie Oliver placed 13th (65.529).
- Individual Competition Abby Fodor placed 5th (67.765) and Evie Oliver placed 13th (65.265) which qualified both of them for the MFS completion where they finished 10th and 14th respectively.

<u>Juniors</u>

- We were able to field a full team again this year. Team athletes in ranked order were: Laila Edwards (MD), Ryleigh Koch (PA), Marley McCourt (NJ) and Ava Noone (PA).
- We placed 4th overall in the Team Competition, less than a point away from a podium finish!
 Individual top 15 results: Laila Edwards placed 5th with a 66.909, Marley McCourt placed 12th with a 65.212.
- All 4 of our Juniors placed in the top 15 of the Individual Competition. Unfortunately, only 3 of the team were able to move to the MFS.
- Laila Edwards brought home the Bronze in the MFS competition with a 71.4 a wonderful end to her career as a Junior as she has aged out this year.

years and we are confident that we will have a short, if not full team, for the debut of the
Childrens Division at NAYC!

Devon's Dressage Explorer s Day - Info Table

We had an information table on Sunday at Devon and with the help of Marley McCourt and her mom, we distributed brochures on USDF Youth Programs, Region 1 Youth Team Challenge and D4K along with giveaways for the kids. Tai's mom also volunteered to apply tattoos to those interested and it was a huge success and helped to drive traffic to our table.

Region 1 FEI Youth Clinic with George Williams, November 23-24, Hilltop

To date we have received 7 applications and of the athletes I know, I expect another We had only 11 applicants this year. It may have been due to the date change (we normally have it the weekend before Thanksgiving. We had 12 additional auditors who came from the mini clinic. Unfortunately, we did not have any GMO sponsorships this year and expenses will reimbursed from next year's NAYC budget.

Mini Clinic with Michael Bragdell

Since our inaugural "mini Clinic" with Michael Bragdell was a huge success last year, we will once again offer it again at Hilltop on the Friday before the FEI Youth Clinic. The intent is to offer an opportunity for the applicants who were not selected to ride with GW to ride with a more senior instructor, in addition to youth who have aspirations of riding in the FEI youth divisions. Athletes selected for the mini-clinic are required to audit at least one day of the GW clinic where they participated in the discussion with GW and the riders during lunch. This clinic provides the athletes and their parents the opportunity to learn more about the various pathways available to youth in our sport, as well as providing them with mentorship opportunities with our current FEI Youth athletes.

Youth Development with Olivia LaGoy

- We are in the process of scheduling our first Region 1 Youth Development Clinic with Olivia LaGoy Weltz this winter in the Pittsburgh area. Olivia has offered to teach these clinics across the region at no cost other than her travel/lodging expenses. Other locations are TBD but will be in areas where we have the most interest.
- They will be initially geared to those athletes with aspirations of competing in the FEI Youth Divisions. If few have openings, current FEI youth riders may be selected.
- Clinic will be a 2-day format with a lesson each day and 2 unmounted educational sessions each day on topics of Veterinary care of horses going to FEI competition; sports psychology; barn/horse management for FEI horses; nutrition for both the 2 and 4 legged athletes.

Region 1 Youth Accomplishments Outside of Competition

The following athletes were nominated and received the Shining Star Award: Taiwan Parrish,
Evie Oliver, Ryleigh Koch, Marley McCourt and Ella Austino. Tai, Evie and Ryleigh are did
receive the Ravel Grant this year and Marley and Ella were not approved until after the 9/30
deadline, they can apply next year for this grant opportunity.
